Dialog's Domain Names database provides comprehensive look-up services for Internet domain names. The file contains over 90 million domain name records. The following tips will help you identify the right tool for your search tasks.

When you want to:	Use This Command:	Example:	Notes:
Search Domain Names	BEGIN b	b domain	Separate multiple files with a comma
Verify the spelling of a term and view similarly-spelled terms	EXPAND e	e OW=Ford Motor	SELECT appropriate e numbered to create a set: SELECT e4 or e6:e9

Top Level Domain	TL=	s TL=edu	Use to limit results to a specific top level domain
Registrar Name	RG=	s RG=alldomains	Expand RG= to view a list of covered registrars
Rotated Domain Name	TR=	s TR=mailroom?	Use in conjunction with trademark files to search a mark that is also a domain name
Current or historical domain records	/whois or /whowas	s NM=sony/whois s NM=sony/whowas	Limit search to retrieve only current or only historical records
Contact Name	NM=	s NM=miramax?	Returns the contact name as presented to the Registrar
Domain Name without TLD	DN=	s DN=piper?	Fields are indexed to allow flexible searching depending on need
Domain Name with TLD	ET=	s ET=piper.com	Fields are indexed to allow flexible searching depending on need
When you want to:	Use This Operator:	Example:	Search Notes:
Request that both terms be present in a record	AND	cat AND dog	Use NOT to eliminate a term s cat NOT dog
Request that either term be present in a record	OR	cat OR dog	Use paratheses to control which operators execute first
Request that search terms be adjacent and in the order entered	(W)	s digital(w)tv	Insert a number to allow intervening words
Request that search terms be adjacent, but in any order	(N)	s digital(n)tv	Insert a number to allow intervening words.

Alerts are saved searches that can be set up to run automatically and deliver the results to your desktop. Follow these easy steps to set up an Alert in the Domain Names database.

Step 1: Enter your search strategy, then **save alert**.

Step 2: Choose the scheduling of the Alert—based on the file's scheduled Alert updates (**u**). Specify whether to remove duplicates and whether to receive notification if no documents are retrieved.

Step 4: Confirm the Alert information is correct. Edit as necessary by entering a line number. Enter **s** to save the Alert settings.

Step 5: Enter a name for your Alert.

Step 6: Enter a PRINT command. Be sure to include format (**/9**) and number of documents (**/all** or **/1-20**) and the specified delivery address (**addr dialog**). Enter **s** to save the Alert.
